- Tracking removal of a raft of logs near Point White. Referred to ACOE. Sent 6/25/18
- Two pump-out stations open at the City Dock. One of four access points reserved 24/7 and marked with yellow whalers. Whalers have been moved to the south side for better visibility on approach and to accommodate larger vessels.

Asylum- WN0335KV—Vessel is fouled on the City's information buoy. Vessel has exceeded 30 consecutive days multiple times and has now exceeded 90 cumulative days in a year. The vessel is being tagged in July under the Derelict Vessel Removal Program.

Derelict Vessel Prevention/Removal Program:

Port Madison Sailboat—This abandoned 36' sailboat was demolished-DVRP grant submitted.

WN6510JR- "Mielke Way" demolished-DVRP grant submitted

ADRIATIC—The sunken fishboat "Adriatic" is still sunk off Liikane property. The owner has refloated and agreed to remove at his own expense.

WN0335KV—ASYLUM: Vessel relocated to private tidelands.

WN7370NS, MARSHALL'S COVE aground July 10th at Manitou Beach Road on an eel grass bed. It had been left at anchor on the Seattle side of the shipping lanes and dragged across. ACOE was in the harbor removing an abandoned float and debris logs. They helped Tami tow the vessel to the City dock. It had oily bilge waste water. NRCC removed 150 gallons of oily wastewater and reported that 40% was oil. The City took emergency custody and the vessel is being process under the DVRP. Custody appeal date ends midnight on September 10th, 2018.
