2. INTRODUCTION OF PW DIRECTOR CHRIS WIERZBICKI

Chris introduced himself to the committee with an overview of work experience at the City of Bainbridge Island and Puget Sound. Rejoined the City on July 31, and looks forward to working with the committee.

4. STATUS REPORTS

A. TERTIARY TREATMENT RFQ

Reviewed the current Proposal from Murray Smith, and discussed the scope of work. Staff is working to bring the scope of work in alignment with the budget. The staff is looking at adding some additional scope to address pretreatment associated with growth of various users such as restaurants, wineries and breweries. The investigation is not a mandated requirement but is good practice.

Discussion on sewer pretreatment requirements and how these can be managed through the various existing city approval and permitting processes.

Committee would like additional background on the selection process for this consultant.

B. BUDGET MID-YEAR STATUS

C. 2020 CIP

Reviewed CIP program for Water, Sewer and Stormwater that will be presented to Council as part of the CIP review process. The detailed CIP highlights the proposed programs for each utility. The committee provided feedback on aspects of the CIP program.

D. PENDING UAC RECOMMENDATIONS TO COUNCIL

The committee has presented recommendations to council on two topics: "heightened review" process and fire flow. The committee is waiting for direction from council as to the next step. The timeframe for direction was a topic of discussion and follow up for the council liaison.

5. SMALL WATER SYSTEMS (CONTINUE DISCUSSION)

The draft discussion memo was reviewed by the committee. The committee requested that staff provide an overview of the current process for obtaining water connections in the city. This would assist the committee in formulating the approach for small water systems.
