4) COMMITTEE REPORTS

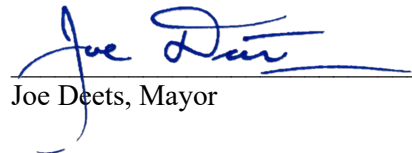

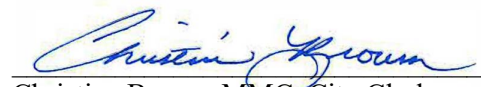
Councilmember Schneider provided an update on a Puget Sound Regional Council Transportation Policy Board meeting.
