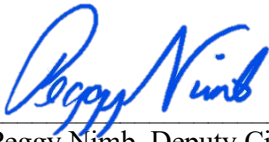
City Manager King introduced the agenda item. Emergency Management Coordinator LeSage provided a presentation, and Council discussed the topic.

4) COMMITTEE REPORTS

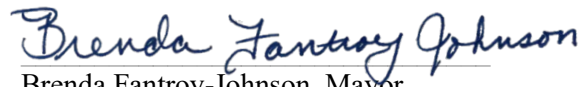
Council provided committee reports and updates on community events.
