City Manager King introduced the agenda item. Public Works Director Wierzbicki provided a presentation, and Council discussed the topic.

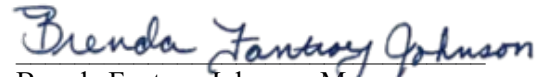
Sewer District #7 Commissioner Sarah Lee provided additional information.
